



Strava Walk/Run Competition

Terms and Conditions

1. Instructions on how to enter and other details contained within promotional advertisements for this competition form part of the conditions of entry.
2. By entering the competition, entrants agree to abide by these Terms and Conditions.
3. The Terms and Conditions of this competition are governed by the laws of the State of Western Australia.
4. The competition is being run by Curtin University, GPO Box U1987, Perth, Western Australia, 6845 ("Curtin University").
5. The Strava Walk/Run Competition ("the competition") commences at 8am Australian Western Standard Time (AWST) on Monday 18 October 2021.
6. The closing time for entering the competition is 11.59pm AWST on Sunday 28 November 2021.
7. Entry to the competition is limited to international students admitted in a course at a Western Australian campus (Curtin Perth Bentley, Curtin Perth City, Curtin Midland, and Curtin Kalgoorlie).
8. To enter the competition, the entrant must:
 - a) Be enrolled in units and studying online in Semester 2, 2021
 - b) Be a travel restricted international student unable to return to Perth WA due to border restrictions
 - c) Have uploaded their competition entries on the event registration form before the closing date
9. Entry to the competition is free. Entrants will be responsible for all costs associated with entering the competition, which may include costs associated with accessing the internet.
10. Entrants may only enter the competition once.
11. Staff employed by Curtin University are not eligible to enter the competition.
12. There will be one (1) prize. This prize will be a Curtin merchandise pack consisting of a Curtin branded towel, coffee mug, winter beanie, soft carry bag and medal.
13. There will be one (1) draw at 10am Australian Western Standard Time on Monday 29 November 2021 at Curtin University Building 101. The winner will be decided based on which student walks or runs the furthest distance during the competition period.
14. The prize winners will be contacted within seven (7) days of the draw by the email address supplied by the entrant on the event registration form.
15. The prize will be mailed to the winner's nominated home address.
16. If the prize winner is under the age of 18 years, the prize will be awarded to the winner's parent or legal guardian.
17. The winner must sign a winner declaration form and consent to their details and photo being publicised on the Curtin website.
18. If a prize winner who has been contacted and been made aware of their prize winning, does not respond to the notification email within twenty-one (21) days of this contact, a new winner will be selected within thirty (30) days of the original draw date, in the same location, and with the same method.



19. The prize winner, or if under the age of 18 years their parent or legal guardian, may be required to provide evidence of their identity (such as photographic ID, birth certificate or current passport) when receiving the prize.
20. Curtin University will bear postage costs of mailing the prizes to the recipient's home address.
21. By entering the competition the entrant agrees that they are over the age of 18 years, or if under the age of 18 years, have their parent's or legal guardian's consent to enter the competition.
22. The prize is not redeemable for cash or an alternative prize.
23. The prize is not transferrable.
